"I told them to keep their head low," Correa said in a phone interview last week.

He confirmed what Santa Ana Mayor Valerie Amezcua publicly quoted him saying as she scolded other Santa Ana City Council members who were critical of revelations that Amezcua, City Manager Alvaro Nuñez and Police Chief Robert Rodriguez misinformed residents about federal immigration enforcement efforts in local neighborhoods.

Attracting Too Much Attention?

Correa – a Democrat who is one of Orange County's most senior members of Congress – is also worried about potential budget impacts to cities if local officials end up on the Trump Administration's radar, especially after a recent executive order targeting sanctuary cities.

Earlier this month, Amezcua, Nuñez and Rodriguez got publicly embarrassed when the Inadvertent published a story detailing federal immigration enforcement activity in the city – despite repeated public assurances of no ICE activity from the three top city officials.

Councilwoman Jessie Lopez seconded that sentiment calling Amezcua unfit for office at the moment, telling Voice of OC, "There is no way that, as an elected leader, I'm going to hide from this battle."

Dear City Manager and Santa Ana Leadership,

My name is Donna Kenefick, and I am a disabled senior residing at Fairhaven Apartments [REDACTED]. I am writing to formally escalate a series of unresolved safety violations, structural hazards, and ongoing disability-based harassment that have been either ignored or superficially addressed by Essex Property Trust and local Code Enforcement.

I have attached evidence including timestamped photos and a sworn declaration documenting:

1. Structural ceiling damage since 2022 that Essex attempted to conceal with caulk instead of repairing
2. Blinding carport lights aimed at my unit, worsening my documented eye condition

Persistent and targeted harassment from the upstairs tenant (Unit 329), with noise, stalking me from room to room and also into my bathroom, and structural stress has been ongoing since March 2024.

Patterns of retaliation and digital interference affecting my medical access and safety have also been a part of landlord harassment and retaliation.

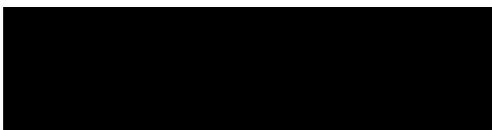
I am respectfully demanding:

1. An independent city inspection of my unit
2. Immediate enforcement against Essex for failing to meet basic habitability and disability accommodation standards
3. A formal response from the City Manager's Office acknowledging receipt and outlining next steps

Subject: Urgent Escalation – Unsafe Housing, Structural Hazards, and Disability Harassment at Fairhaven Apartments

Dear City Manager,

I am a disabled senior and long-time resident of Fairhaven Apartments. I am writing to formally escalate multiple unresolved issues.

1. Blinding Carport Lights – Retaliatory & Dangerous Environmental Interference

On the evening of April 25, 2025, my security camera recorded glaring high-intensity carport lights shining directly into my unit. Attached is a timestamped still image showing the extent of this blinding interference. For someone in my condition, it is a safety hazard.

2. Ongoing Structural Damage Since 2022 – Covered Up, Not Fixed

Major ceiling separation in my unit, first documented in late 2022, was caused by a violent impact tied to tenant activity in the hallway.

The problem has been further aggravated by the current tenant in Unit 329, whose behavior includes repeated, forceful banging on doors and walls.

My attached declaration and photos (taken in 2022) show:

- Widening ceiling-beam gaps
- Cracking near load-bearing points
- Continued signs of structural stress and shifting

To date, Essex has refused to conduct a proper structural inspection or perform legitimate repairs.

3. Pattern of Harassment, Digital Interference, and Retaliation

In addition to physical safety concerns, I have endured extensive harassment—including suspicious phone calls, unauthorized access to my unit, and threats of eviction.

I've made these complaints repeatedly through proper channels, but I have been ignored, dismissed, or retaliated against for speaking up.


Requested Action

- Immediate inspection of my unit by an independent city-approved inspector
- Enforcement action against Essex Property Trust for failing to maintain habitable housing
- Oversight into the handling of disability-related complaints and possible civil rights violations

Please acknowledge receipt of this letter and inform me of the steps your office will take to address these critical issues.

The following photos document extensive structural separation between my ceilings and walls, directly resulting from damage caused by Jesse, the former tenant in Unit 329. Rather than address the issue properly, Essex Property Trust attempted to conceal the damage using caulk-a superficial and ineffective cover-up. To date, no permanent repairs have been made.

The situation has continued to deteriorate, especially under the current tenant in Unit 329, who has worsened the strain on the structure through ongoing harassment, intimidation, and targeted stalking that includes tracking my movements from room to room-even into the bathroom. This constant stress and structural neglect has created a dangerous and hostile living environment.

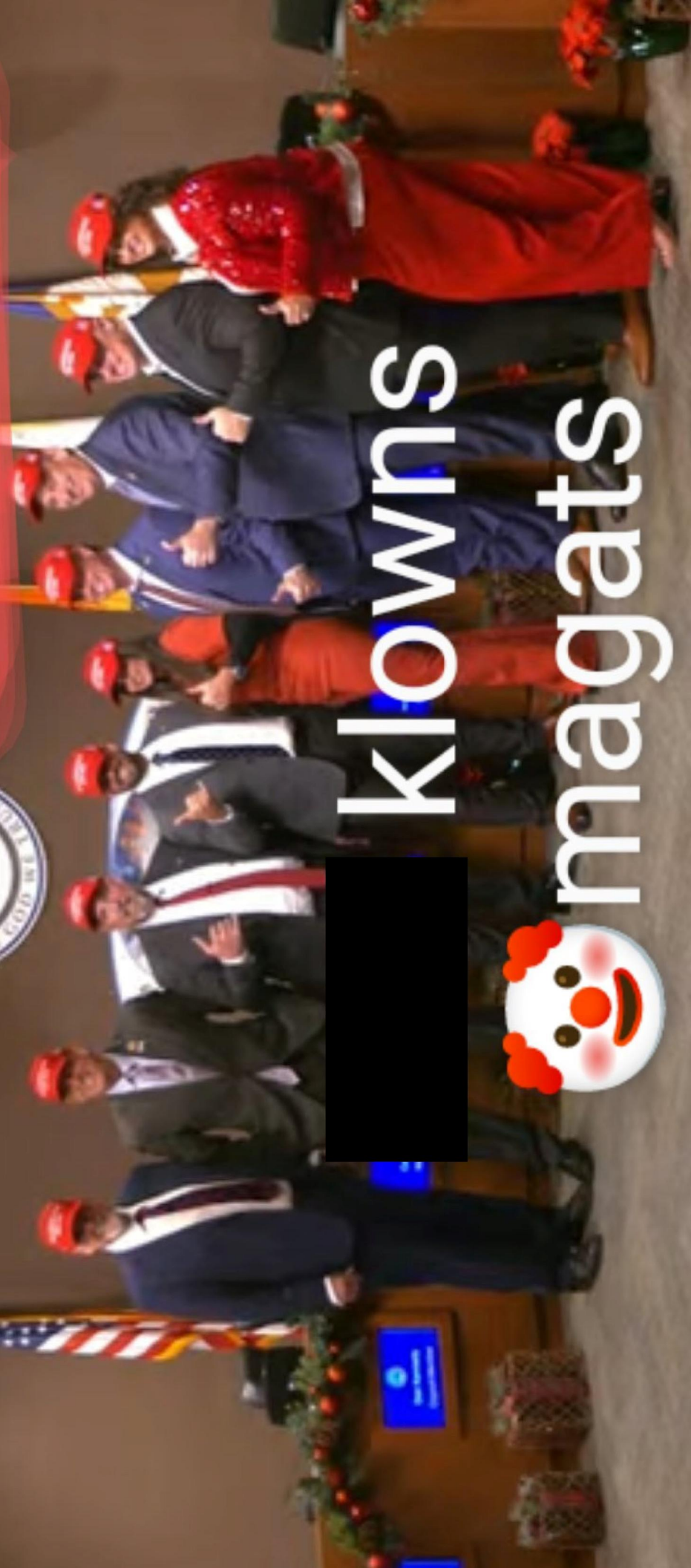

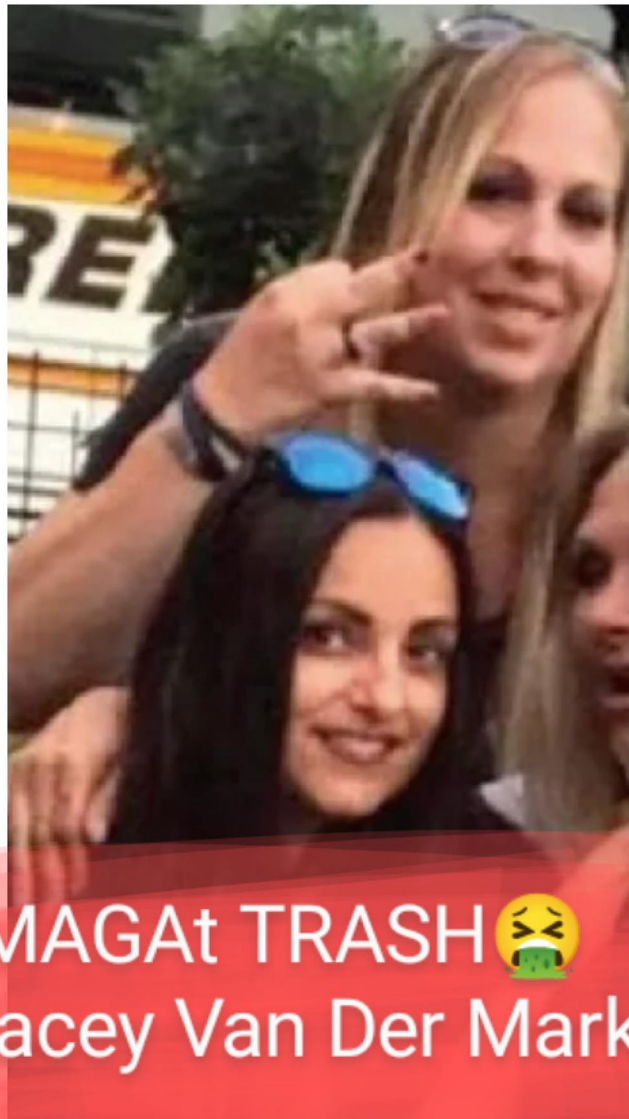

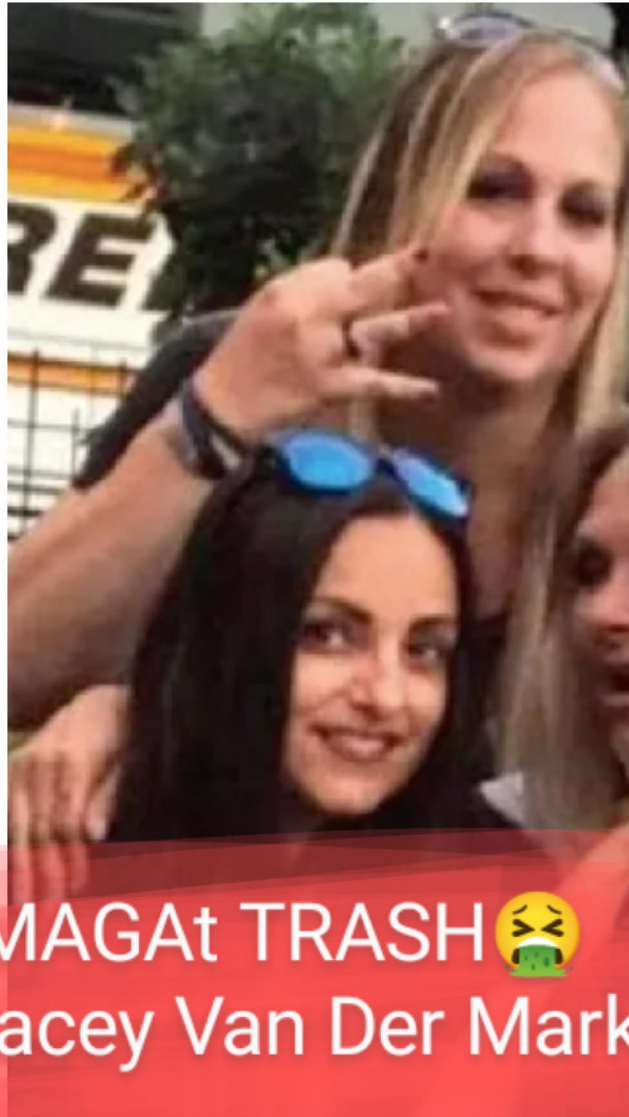

SAN DIEGO (Border Report) — Baja's Transpeninsular Highway reopened Wednesday night after protesters used tree trunks, branches and a car to block traffic for about two days.

Residents in the small town about 200 miles south of the U.S.-Mexico border said they were upset with the state government for cutting back on resources and programs for their local schools. Starting Monday night, they stopped all vehicles, including hundreds of U.S.-bound tractor-trailers loaded with merchandise and tons of perishable freight.
