

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO POOL MAINTENANCE
SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH SERVICE FIRST**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT is entered into this 5th day of March 2024, by and between Service First (“Contractor”), and the City of Santa Ana, a charter city and municipal corporation duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of California (“City”).

RECITALS

- A. On February 21, 2023, the City entered into Agreement # A-2023-021 with Contractor to provide pool maintenance services for five (5) of the City’s pool sites.
- B. In accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement, the parties desire to amend the total compensation due under the Agreement.

THE PARTIES THEREFORE AGREE:

- 1. **Section 2.a., COMPENSATION**, shall be amended to read as follows: City agrees to pay, and Contractor agrees to accept as total payment for its services for City, the rates and charges identified in Contractor’s Fee Proposal, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference as **Exhibit B**. The total amount to be expended during the term of this Agreement shall not exceed \$2,988,810.00, which is allocated as: 1) a base rate of \$2,391,048.00; and 2) a twenty percent (20%) contingency in the amount of \$597,762.00.00 for additional and as-needed services, to be exercised at City’s sole discretion.
- 2. Except as hereinabove modified, the terms and conditions of said Agreement remain unchanged and in full force and effect.


