Mayor and City councilmembers,

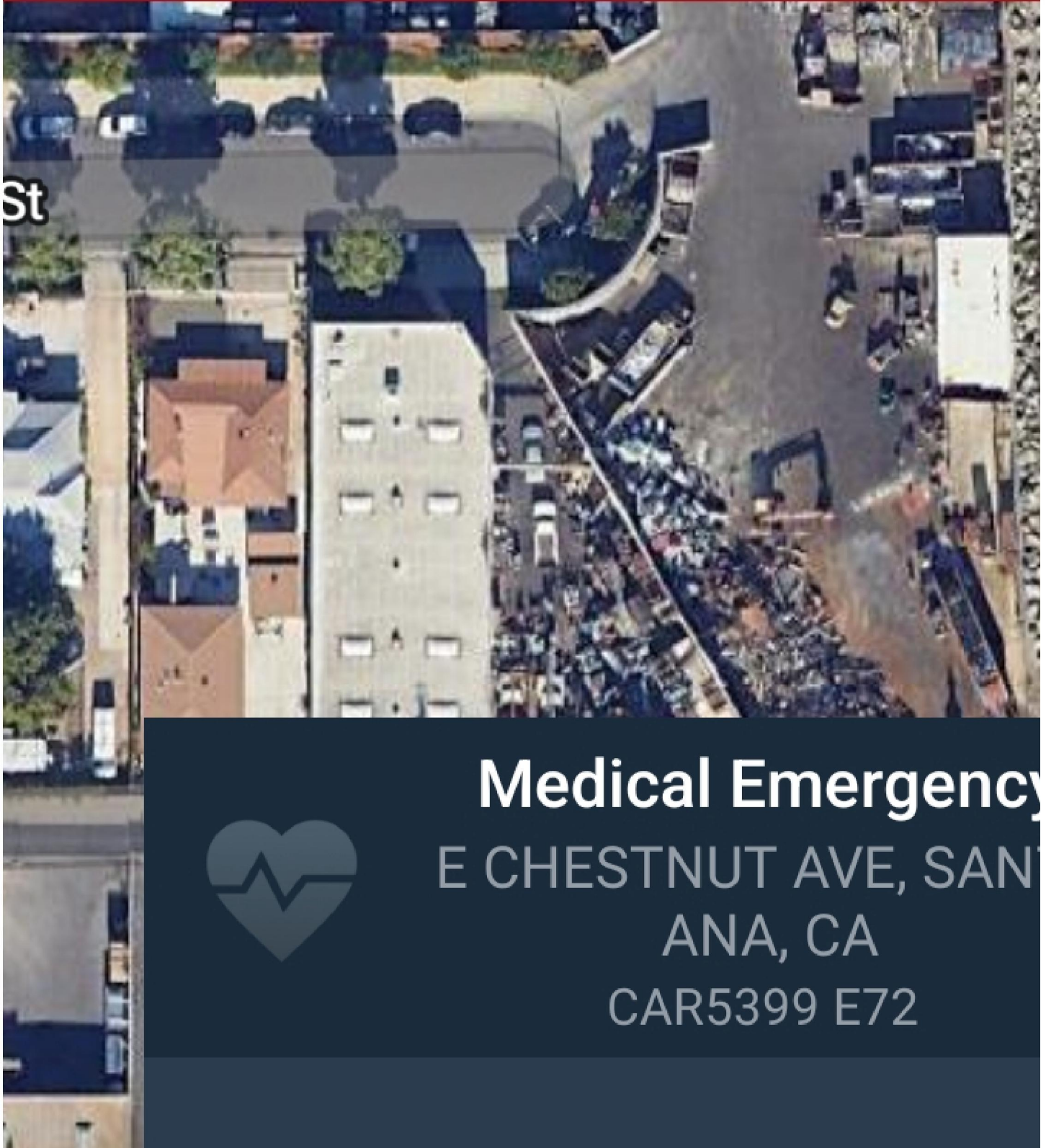
I heard students from Villa elementary were walking home from school yesterday, and came across a body at the 1000 block of E. Chestnut and railroad property.

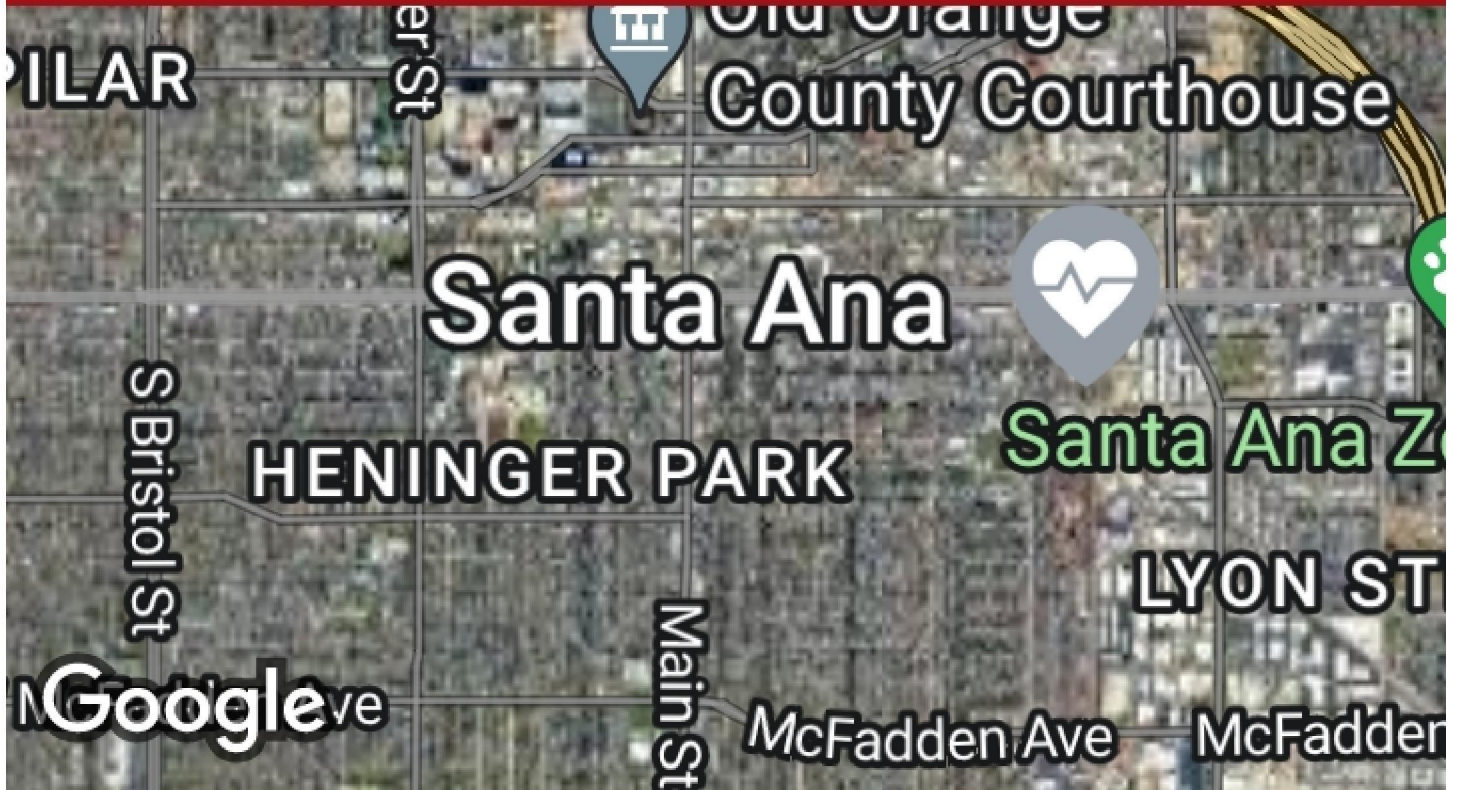
