# Total COVID-19 Cases to Date

---

- The OC Health Care Agency has released updated data that shows Santa Ana has seen an increase of 624 new cases in the past 14 days.
- The total number of cases is now 48,658.



# Case Positivity

---

- As of September 2021, Santa Ana's case positivity rate is 5.6.
  - There are only 14 other cities with a lower rate.
- Orange County's case positivity rate is 5.9 percent.

# Testing

---

- Get tested if...
  - You have symptoms of COVID-19, whether or not you are vaccinated.
  - Don't have symptoms but have a known COVID-19 exposure or exposure concerns.
  - Are an essential worker with frequent contacts with the public.
  - Even if fully vaccinated, COVID-19 testing may be recommended if you are:
    - Returning from international travel.

- Since May 2020, the City has disbursed a total of \$16,036,030 to assist 2,791 families with funding from the Department of Housing and Urban Development and the Department of Treasury.
  - We're currently disbursing over \$604,000 per week.
