General Fund Performance

- FY20-21 Sales Tax and Business Tax performed better than anticipated
- FY20-21 Expenditure Savings during the Pandemic
 - Parks and Libraries were not at full service
 - Staff vacancies remained vacant
 - Pandemic priorities funded by CARES supplanted regular operations
 - Departments were more careful and controlled spending during pandemic uncertainty
- The updated Sales Tax estimate for FY21-22 means the City does not need to use General Fund balance for the FY21-22 operating budget
- Final Result: The FY 21-22 budget is balanced, and the General Fund has \$42 million available for one-time spending

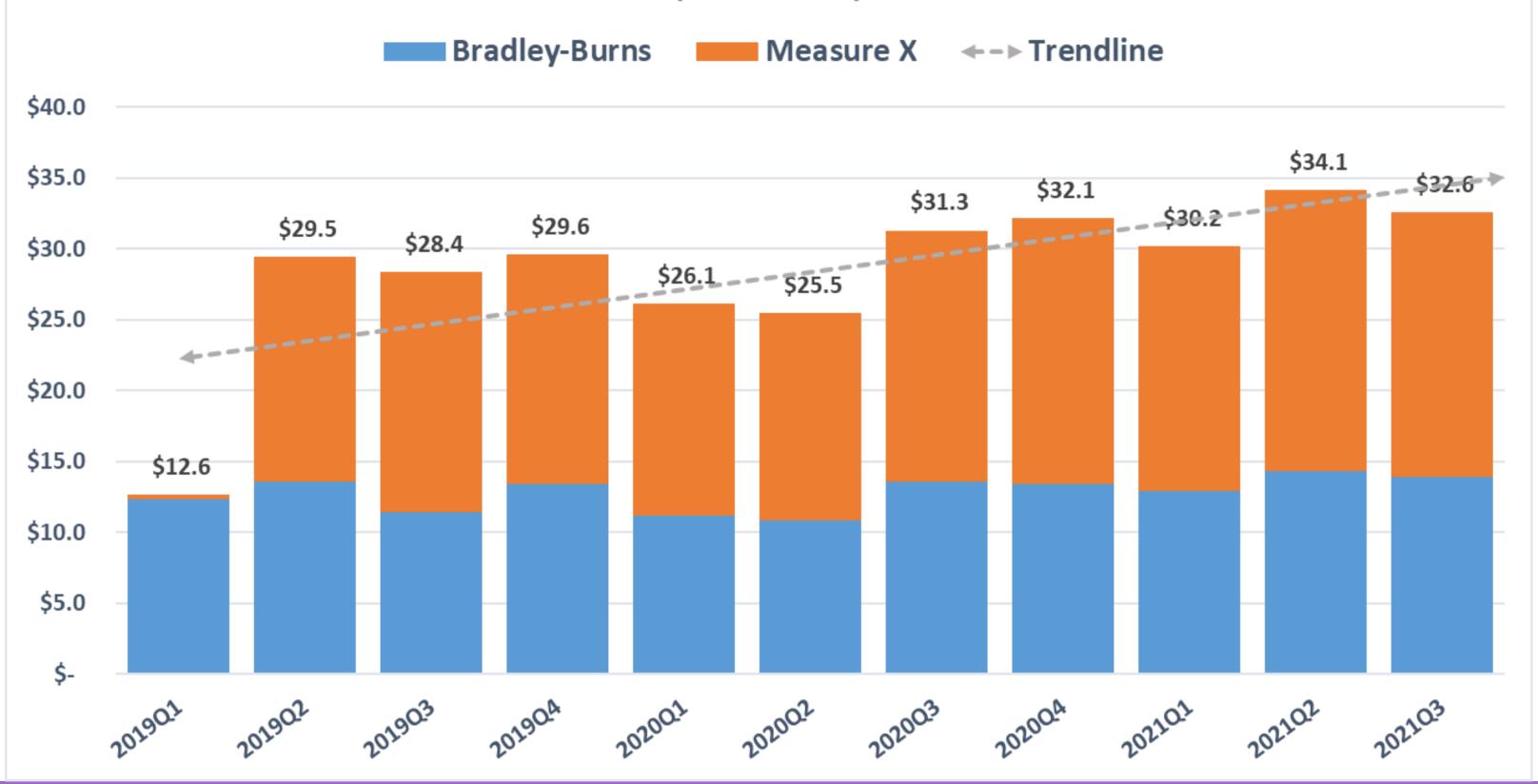
