

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT WITH iWATER, INC., FOR WATER SYSTEM
COMPUTER MODELING AND ENGINEERING SERVICES**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT to the above-referenced agreement is entered into on October 3, 2023, by and between iWater, Inc., a California corporation (“Consultant”), and the City of Santa Ana, a charter city and municipal corporation organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of California (“City”).

RECITALS

- A. The parties entered into Agreement No. A-2020-049 (“Agreement”) dated April 1, 2020, to retain a qualified contractor to provide water system computer modeling and engineering services to the Water Services Division of the Public Works Agency.
- B. The parties executed the first of two (2) one- (1) year extensions on March 24, 2023 (A-2020-049-01). The Agreement is in full force and effect through March 31, 2024.
- C. The parties now wish to amend the Agreement to exercise the final extension and increase compensation.


The Parties therefore agree:

- 1. Pursuant to the section titled, “**Scope of License Grant**,” of the Agreement, the final extension is hereby exercised for an additional one-year period, from April 1, 2024 through March 31, 2025. Any insurance certificates are required to be extended and/or renewed to cover this final extension.
- 2. Pursuant to the “**Contract Total**,” in **Exhibit A** of the Agreement, the compensation is hereby amended to increase annual compensation by \$120,000 for the remainder of the Agreement.
- 3. Except as modified by this First Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
